

Dear greeters!

Thank you for your time and commitment to helping to be that welcoming face of Christ to all who walk through our doors each and every weekend.

**Goals for our greeters.**

- Goal #1 – Father would like to see us **have at least 3 greeters per Mass**. This way at least 1 person can greet at the front door for visitors and at least 2 people can greet on the side entrance by the car port.
- Goal #2 --Father would like greeters to be at Church **30 minutes early** and to wear your name tag so people can easily ask for your assistance if needed. I made some more name tags so if you do not see your name, please let me know so I can make one for you.  
→As soon as Father begins to process into Church you are no longer expected to greet but may go in and participate in the Celebration of the Eucharist. If you see a couple late comers feel free to stay for a little bit and help greet them and help them find a seat in Church if needed.
- Goal #3 --The greeters should strive to personally **welcome each person** with a “Good Morning/Evening” or a short chat about the weather. Something to be that warm and friendly face of Christ – inviting all to Come and See the goodness of the Lord.
- Goal #4 **--If someone looks new**, please go out of your way to introduce yourself to them and let them know if they need anything to feel free to ask. Please help all those who look lost or maybe need to find the restroom.
- Goal #5 --Remember to keep a special attention for those who need assistance due to their physical limitations. Helping those in wheelchairs maneuver through the doors, find a seat in Church, etc.  
--If for some reason you are the only one by the car port doors – feel free to hit the handicap button that opens both doors to help greet.
- Goal #6 --When you are scheduled in the future, **if you cannot greet at the assigned Mass in which you were scheduled** - please try to find a replacement. After you have made attempts to call a replacement and still cannot, please notify me. We want to make sure that there are greeters at every Mass to welcome!
